


Discipling: Getting Started

There is no “one-size fits all” way to disciple. The primary “curriculum” is Jesus himself, and our own pursuit of him (1 Cor 11:1). Thus, relationships of trust and the desire for Christ-like transformation form the key to any discipling group.

Initial Questions for a New Group

1. What are you thankful for today?
2. Are you speaking with God daily? What does this look like?
3. Are you reading God’s Word daily? What is Jesus saying? How are you responding?
4. Reading the Word Together:
 - a. Starter Passages: Ps. 32, Is. 55, Mat. 5, John 15, Rom. 8, Gal. 5, Eph. 4, or James 1
 - b. Read and Ask – What is Jesus saying? How are we being called to respond?
4. How can we best pray for you this week?
